## Overview

The **Low Income Home Energy Assistance Program (LIHEAP)** is a federal program that started in 1981 and is funded by Congress yearly. In Indiana, LIHEAP can assist low-income families with heating costs during the winter. This program stops utility companies from shutting off heating services when the weather is very cold. If your utility service is at risk of being turned off, contact GSN to make an appointment. In the meantime, please keep paying your bill.

## Required for Applicants

1

Copies of PAY STUBS for each household member's income for the prior 3 months.

2

If you receive Social Security Benefit, a copy of the SOCIAL SECURITY LETTER stating the amount paid for the current year.

3

If you are over 18 years of age and IN SCHOOL, a copy of the current class schedule.

4

Copy of HEATING/ELECTRIC bills(s).

This program, provided through the Good Samaritan Network, is available for Hamilton County residents only. It offers one-time help to pay for the primary heating source.

Homeowners and renters can both apply, even if heating costs are included in their rent.

There are income limits, so please check the eligibility table for details. Eligibility depends on household size and the gross annual income of everyone in the household who is 18 or older.

Being eligible for the Energy Assistance Program (LIHEAP) does not guarantee help. The amount of assistance you receive depends on the LIHEAP funds available for the year.
